This is a **three week** jury trial calendar beginning on **Monday**, **April 22**, **2019**. All cases are on a two hour call and do not need to appear unless called by the Court. Cases involving *pro se* parties must appear ready to go forward on April 22, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. **THE CASES WILL NOT BE CALLED IN THE ORDER IN WHICH THEY ARE PUBLISHED.** Parties and counsel must be ready for trial when reached and continuance will only be granted for legal cause.

Counsel and pro se parties must make a **WRITTEN REPORT** of the following information to RITU BAHRI, Staff Attorney, via facsimile (404-730-5442) or email (ritu.bahri@fultoncountyga.gov) no later than **Thursday, April 11, 2019**. The report must be timely made as to each calendar on which the case appears.

- 1. Expected length of trial;
- 2. Phone and email addresses for all parties;
- 3. Whether the trial will need to be reported, and if so, what portions. The trial will not be transcribed absent a timely request for a court reporter; and
- 4. Possibilities for settlement.
- 5. For cases in which a Case Management Order was entered mandating mediation, mediation MUST be completed before the start of the trial calendar. The parties must certify that the mediation requirement has been satisfied. Failure by the parties to complete mediation within the required time-frame, unless excused or extended in writing by this Court, shall result in sanctions imposed against the non-complying party.

The following must be **efiled** with a **hard paper copy** delivered to the Judge's Chambers no later than **Thursday**, **April 11**, **2019**:

- 1. **Consolidated Pre-Trial Order** Plaintiff shall be responsible for consolidating the Pre-Trial Order. No party shall submit their own portion of the Pre-Trial Order to the Court without written certification detailing their good faith efforts to present the Court with a consolidated Order.
- 2. **Motions in Limine** and any other pre-trial matters.

Responses to the motions in limine must be submitted to the Court no later than **April 16, 2019**.

Deadlines set forth in case management orders supercede any conflicting deadlines set forth in this notice.

The parties shall bring a hard copy of the **Requests to Charge** on the morning of trial— Parties are limited to 15 requests to charge excluding any Pattern requests, absent good cause shown.

If neither party has filed a jury demand in your case, the case will proceed with a Bench Trial and the parties will not be required to submit a Consolidated Pre-Trial Order.

Failure to provide a written report as set forth above and/or failure to submit a Consolidated Pre-Trial Order in a timely manner may result in sanctions, including the striking of pleadings.

Counsel must notify the Staff Attorney immediately if a case has settled.

TRIAL INSTRUCTIONS

The Court only provides a television (with a USB drive) and DVD player and does not provide any other audio/video equipment. Counsel must arrange privately for any other equipment that may be required at trial.

All exhibits must be marked and shown to opposing counsel BEFORE trial. All parties must prepare a list of exhibits to present to the Court at the start of trial which must set forth a brief description of each.
